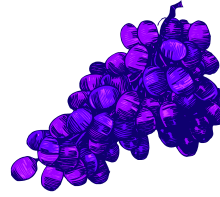

During Grape Harvesting”**

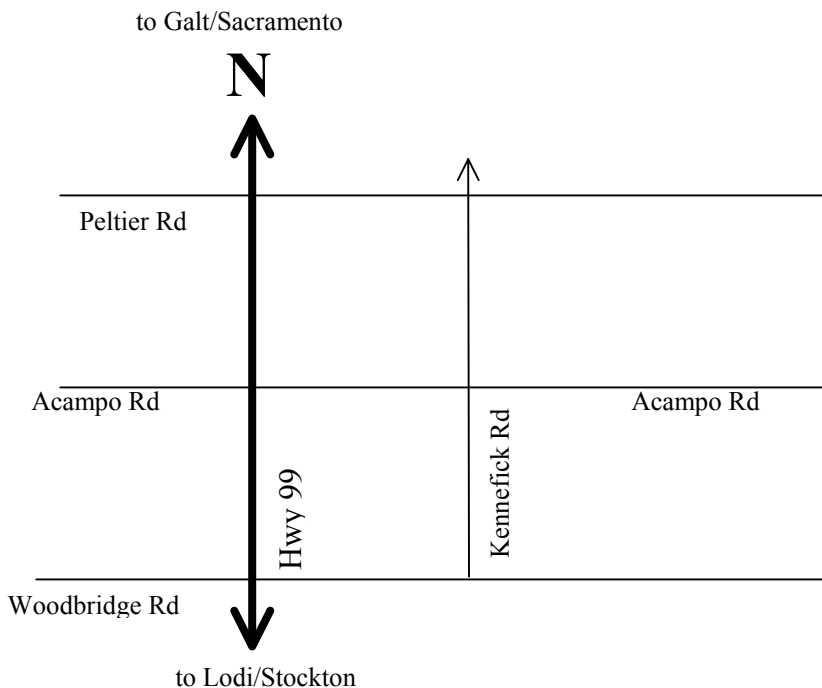

Dr. Kent Daane, Paul Verdegaal, and Chuck Ingels will discuss various precautions that growers and field workers should take when harvesting grapes in vineyards infested with Vine Mealybug to prevent its spread to non-infested vineyards.

Both hand-harvesting and machine harvesting will be discussed. There will be ample time for questions regarding scenarios that might occur during harvest. Harvesting equipment will be on hand to demonstrate and discuss sanitation practices. Postharvest Vine Mealybug management strategies will be discussed, including appropriate pesticides and issues of use as specified on their labels.
