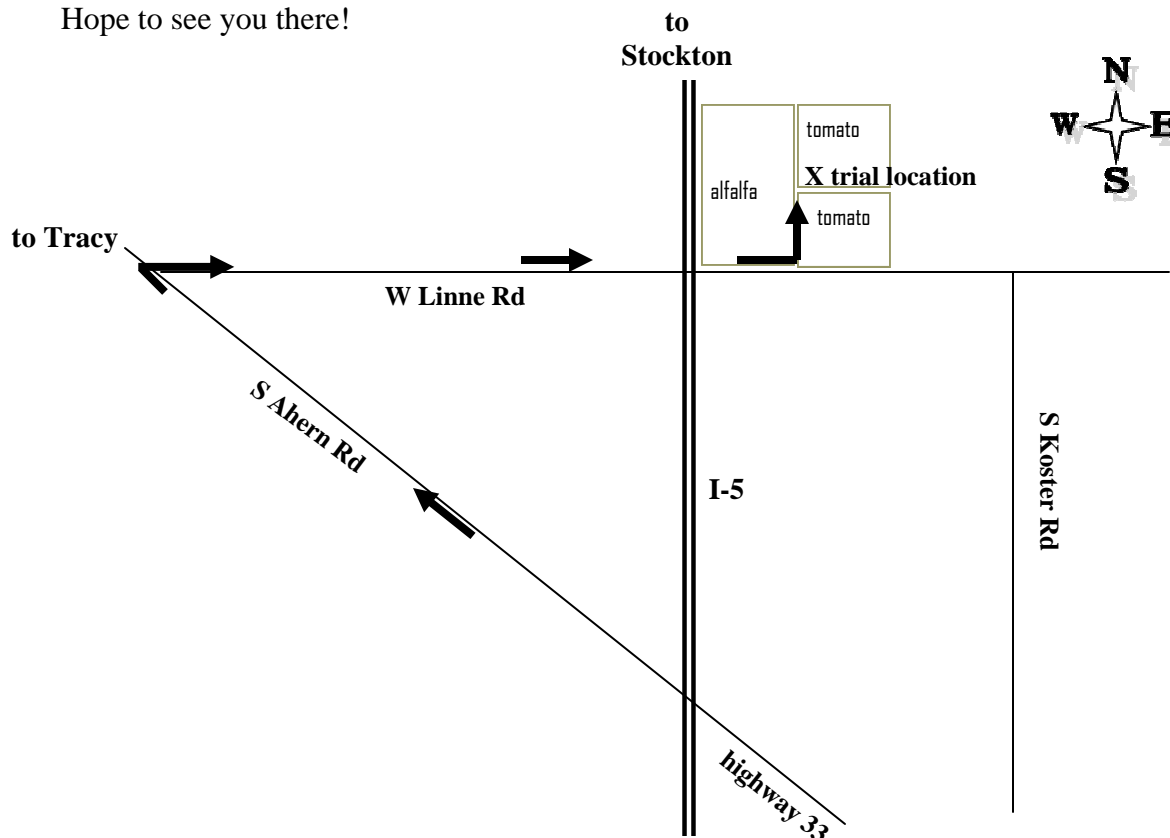
2009 SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY UC COOPERATIVE EXTENSION PROCESSING TOMATO VARIETY TRIAL FIELD DAY

FRIDAY **SEPTEMBER 18, 2009** 10 a.m.—12 p.m.

This year's processing tomato variety trial includes 16 replicated varieties and an additional 14 varieties in single plots. The trial was established by transplanting on May 7th and is drip-irrigated. Co-operator is Hal Robertson Farms of Tracy. There is some soil-borne disease pressure and some variation in how the varieties are holding up, but in general the trial looks really good. Come take a look!

To reach the field, exit I-5 at Highway 33 (exit 452). Head NW on Ahern Rd. and take the next right on Linne Road. Follow Linne over I-5 and the trial field will be the block just north of the first tomato field on your left as you descend down the overpass. Look for a UCCE Tomato Field Day sign and turn left at the dirt road between the alfalfa and tomato fields on Linne.
